

A Quorum of the Executive Committee was Present: Hal Persun, President; Heath Stanley, Treasurer; Margot Handscomb, Secretary; 509 PIATrustees: Philip Handscomb, Lee Barber, Matt Anderson; Past Presidents, John Devanie; Greg Velasco, Dave Bush. Special Projects, Barry Simpson. June Housman, Housman & Assoc. Also in attendance were all 509 PIA members in good standing, who were in Tacoma for the 509 PIA Reunion.

AGENDA TOPICS:

- I. The Membership meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance. The minutes of the last General Membership Meeting were read by the current Secretary, Margot Handscomb, and approved. Our Treasurer, Heath Stanley reported on our current bank acct. balance of approximately \$17,004. For the year we have taken in \$7,670 in dues, and we have had expenditures \$6,325, which leaves a profit of \$1,399. Hal Persun congratulated our Treasurer, Heath Stanley on the great job he is doing. Huge applause for Heath.
- II. Again this year as last, there was a discussion of increasing membership in the 509 PIA. Our officers, trustees, and members attend many events throughout the year, and it was recommended by June Housman that we set up a membership table at these events, so we could make membership in the 509 PIA available on the spot. Setting up Pay Pal on our website was again recommended, and Heath, Barry, Matt and June are going to exchange info and work to make that a reality. Other member and revenue suggestions were: A link to Amazon on our website, USAA credit card bonuses, links on other military assoc. sites, and a suggested link to the 173rd with which we have a close association. These other suggestions will be investigated and discussed in future meetings or conference calls.
- III. With the increasingly tight military budget, getting a color guard from any of the 509 Battalions is more and more improbable, and we did not have one at this reunion. June Housman will arrange for a color guard for the reunion in 2016. For the future we need to look into using other sources for our color guard: local VFW or Veteran groups, local high school ROTC color guard groups, getting uniforms for some of our members and forming our own color guard, etc.
- IV. Fort Benning was nominated for the 509 PIA 2016 Reunion site, and was unanimously selected. The date will in May, 2016 to correspond with the 75th anniversary of the formation of the 509th. Matt Anderson is looking into the WWII reenactment team doing the jump. We are also looking into the 509 Living History Unit being at the reunion.
- V. Suggestions were made for the site of the 2017 reunion, 6 cities were suggested and there was a vote to choose the top 3. The 3 cities chosen were: Shreveport, LA; San Antonio, TX; and Kansas City, MO. The city will be voted on at the 2016 General Membership Meeting at Ft. Benning, GA.

- VI. A change to the current By-laws was no presented, seconded, voted on, and passed, which states that, "Only 509 veterans can serve as President or Vice President of the 509th PIA."
- VII. Barry Simpson presented Special Projects:
 - a. New "Order of Geronimo" and the new medal that would be presented (designed by Tryggvi Larum) as part of "Order of Geronimo." There will be a \$500 set up fee, individual medals \$12 each, Ribbons \$2 each. Motion to adopt, seconded, and unanimously voted in. Tryggvi Larum voted to receive one of the first medals.
 - b. Motion to investigate a 509 Tax Free Corporate Foundation and bring info to the 2016 meeting. Motion seconded and unanimously approved.
- VIII. Hal Persun reviewed some of last year's activities by members of the 509 PIA and encouraged more members to get involved.
- IX. Discussion of Officers and Executive Committee members including the fact that Hal Persun will be stepping down as President of the 509 PIA for personal reasons. He will be sorely missed. Nominations and election of Officers and Committee members followed and the results are as follows:
