Dear Fellow Troopers,

The 38th Annual Airborne Awards Festival will be held this year on 1-4 April 2015 at the Atlanta Airport Marriott Hotel, 4711 Best Road, College Park, GA. This is the same hotel that we have used the past several years.

The theme of this year's Festival will be recognizing our Korean War paratroopers. We are excited that our Guest of Honor and Awards Banquet Guest Speaker this year will be General (Retired) Charles C. "Hondo" Campbell, a decorated Viet Nam veteran who commanded at all levels, and was the Commanding General of US Army forces in Korea as a Lieutenant General. As such, he is intimately familiar with the Korean War and the current situation on the peninsula. He is a paratrooper, Special Forces qualified and recipient of many awards and decorations including the Distinguished Service Medal.

We are also excited to announce new additions this year. In addition to the Ft Benning trip, we are offering a day trip hosted by the Atlanta History Center. We will also receive a briefing on the White Tigers of the Korean War on Saturday by Colonel (Ret) Ben S. Malcom. We will again be entertained during the banquet by the 18-member Sentimental Journey Orchestra.

The Airport Marriott is about ten minutes from Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta Airport. The hotel has a shuttle that will bring you from the airport to the hotel at no charge. Self-parking is free, but you will have to pay for valet parking. Check in time for the hotel is 3 PM. If you arrive before that time, our hospitality room will be open for your convenience, where all those that have arrived before you will be waiting. You must make your reservations before March 9. Make your reservations early to ensure you get the accommodations that best suit your needs. Your hotel reservation form is included. MAIL it directly to the hotel. DO NOT send it with your Airborne Awards registration.

IMPORTANT NEWS:

BENNING TRIP: This trip will entail a bus trip to Benning, a wreath-laying ceremony at the Airborne Walk, a demonstration by the 1-507th PIR about Airborne School, lunch with members of the 1-507th, and a visit to the National Infantry Museum's Armored Vehicle Restoration Facility that is housed in BG George Patton's 2nd Armored Division 1941 Tank Repair Building. Unfortunately, there is no Airborne 5th Jump & Graduation this week, and due to funding constraints, we are not allowed to participate in live-fire. We are attempting to schedule other events, e.g., Ranger graduation, etc. Watch for updates on our website: www.82nd-atl.com.

ATLANTA HISTORY CENTER TRIP: This trip will entail a bus trip to local historical locations in Atlanta. We will leave the Marriott at 1100 and travel a short distance for lunch at Mary Mac's Tea Room, an Atlanta Landmark since 1945. After lunch we will re-board the bus and travel another short distance to the Atlanta History Center located on 30-plus acres in Midtown Atlanta. The History Center has over 1,500 original Civil War artifacts on display along with photographs, dioramas, videos and more. This is one of our nation's largest exhibitions of original Civil War artifacts. Included at the history center is the 1996 Olympic Games museum and "Down the Fairway with Bobby Jones" which describes the evolution of the world-famous Masters Tournament and the development of the modern game of golf.

AIRBORNE AWARDS PROGRAM OUTLINE

Wednesday April 1 This is the date of the Early Bird Party. The hospitality room will open at 12 Noon, on the Lobby Level (follow the signs) and will provide a place for the early arrivals to enjoy themselves until their rooms are available. Hotel Rooms are not available until after 3 pm.

<u>Thursday April 2</u> The buses will depart from the Hotel at 8 AM sharp for Fort Benning and 11 AM sharp for the Atlanta History Center. We will return to the Hotel by 6 PM, have the evening free for a leisurely dinner and hold another Quick Draw in the Hospitality Room at 10 PM.

Friday April 3 The first official function of the Festival, the Memorial Luncheon, takes place today at Noon. The Cocktail Hour begins at 11 AM to give everyone a chance to mingle while you find your way to your table (open seating) and meet the new arrivals of the morning. The Memorial Service is dedicated to the memory of all the Troopers lost in combat during the past 70 years. Prior to the luncheon at 9:30 AM, there will be an update briefing by the 82nd Airborne Division, giving us a rundown of their activities during the past year and a readiness update of the Division. Following the luncheon at 3PM, there will be an update briefing by the 101st Airborne (Air Assault)

Division, giving us a rundown of their activities during the past year and a readiness update of the Division. The evening will be free for Unit meetings, a leisurely dinner or whatever you choose to do. If there is enough interest, we will hold a Quick Draw at 10 PM in the Hospitality Room and one lucky person could walk away with \$1000. There will be other winners of \$25 and \$50. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO BE PRESENT TO WIN.

Saturday April 4 At 9:30 AM COL (Ret) Ben S. Malcom will provide a briefing on the White Tigers of Korean War fame. This will be a very informative briefing and is in-line with our theme of honoring Korean War paratroopers. COL Malcom was recently inducted into the Georgia Veterans Hall of Fame, and is a true American hero. The ladies will have a brunch at 10 AM, with games and prizes. The Awards Banquet will begin with Cocktails at 6 PM and the Banquet will begin at 7 PM. Following dinner, to finish out the evening, we will have the Airborne Awards presentations and the recognition of Airborne Achievements by the members of the various Airborne Organizations across the Country. After the Awards presentations, we will dance to the great sounds of the Sentimental Journey Orchestra in the ballroom, then adjourn to the Hospitality Room where festivities will continue until 2 AM.

The legends, the heroes, the organizers and the planners of the Airborne World turn out for this <u>ALL</u> Airborne Festival, from WWII to present day, along with the leaders of most National Airborne Organizations.

The entire Festival is staged for the benefit of every person who has ever served in the Airborne.
