SUBJECT: Repatriation of American Personnel and Awards.

TO : Commanding Officer, 428th Replacement Co., APC #372, U. S. Army.

1. In reference to attached true copy of letter from Pvt. DONALD L. SUTTON, 36159286, a former enlisted man of this organization, records of this Headquarters show that Pvt. SUTTON was interned in Spanish Morocco from 8 November 1942 to 1 March 1943. This information should be entered on Service Record and Form #20.

2. Attention is invited to enclosed letter, AG 383.6 P-O, Hq. NATOUSA, 12 July 1944, Subject: Repatriation of American Personnel. The provisions of this circular (See Par. 1c) apply to Pvt. SUTTON.

3. Soldier is entitled to American Defense Service Medal, and is authorized to wear the Distinguished Unit Badge. He is also entitled to have the Regimental Crest of the 3rd Zouaves and to have this information and letter concerning British Parachute Beret in his 201 File. He has not fulfilled the qualifications for the Combat Infantry Badge. Soldier was favorably considered for the Good Conduct Medal.
