3. The Commanding General, Port of Debarkation, is hereby authorized to place the above named enlisted men on temporary duty with POW Military Intelligence Service, Washington, D.C. for a period not to exceed three (3) days.

4. Enlisted men will notify correspondents and Publishers to discontinue mailing letters and publications until further advised as to new address.
